

ADHOC CRISIS



In terms of procedure, this committee will not be very different from the other committees. However, due to a large volume of crisis, Directives, Communiqués and Press Releases will be one of the main methods of working in this committee. Delegates are encouraged to be familiar with this procedure and usage. A brief description of the three is:

Directives: Direct an action of a delegation, body, person, which would be reasonably within a delegate's capability. An example could be the Delegate of China mobilizing additional 10,000 troops to guard its borders. A committee directive would act like a 'mini draft resolution' that can be passed by the committee on a particular crisis. It should not be longer than a few lines or clauses. It is a type of short-term solution to the crisis.

Communiqués: A form of communication between countries, bodies or any specific person. Communiqués can also be from multiple delegates or even the whole committee. This could even be written to the government of your own country before taking any big step against the other country.

Press Release: It can again be from a single delegate or the whole committee. They are used to make public statements, and should only be used when delegate/committee feels that there is any information that the public would benefit from or be affected by.

This committee is a futuristic committee which i.e. AD HOC Crisis, 2018. So the timeline of the events post 2015 is as follows:

2015:

China launched an exploration survey in the South China Sea and they successfully discovered oil in the South China Sea. China immediately claimed all of it on the basis of past claims over the South China Sea.

But after some weeks, a shocking news came up where Peoples Republic of China signed a deal with Russia and Japan to help China extracting oil and also sharing it with them. It was distributed as China: 70%; Russia: 20% and Japan.

2016

This was a very remarkable year for the people of Syria as the six year long uprising came to an end, when the Syrian troops backed out. Bashar Al Assad was found guilty for violating many Human Rights and international laws. Mr. Assad's trial was held in the International Court of Justice.

Later in the year, Flight PK 711 departing from Karachi, Pakistan towards New York, United States of America blasted when it was fl. No record of the civilian casualties.



Another shocking news came when Flight QF833 from Canberra, Australia to Tehran, Islamic Republic of Iran went missing near Vietnam. The radar lost track of the flight and it's whereabouts are still unknown.

November: United States of America was in a state of festivity as Hillary Rodhan Clinton was elected as the 58th President of the United States of America. Ms. Clinton is the first woman president of the United States of America.

December: During extraction of oil in the South China Sea, two Russian ships were attacked and they were blasted. Russian President Vladimir Putin claimed that it was the 7th fleet of the United States of America, which was accountable for this attack. On which United States completely refuses and says it's a false allegation.

2017:

United Kingdom's NATO air force station was bombed and the UK intelligence service started an operation to find out the organization behind the blast.

There was an infiltration by Islamic State in India. Sabarmati Ashram, Ahemdabad was bombed and Vidhan Sabha, Gandhinagar was hijacked. In the National Security Council's operation which was successful, 27 extremists were found, out of which 21 were dead and 6 are being interrogated who claim that there are total 33 extremists who planned the attack. The where abouts of 6 other extremists are unknown.

2018:

This year started with no big happenings. The thing, which drew the attention of the entire world, was when the Russian Soldiers entered the territory of Ukraine infiltrating the area. This took place in the month of March and the infiltration still continues.
